



BLUEBERRIES

VARIETIES

AURORA	Medium berries ripen just slightly after Elliot. Nice sweet flavor. Easy to grow, with a slightly spreading habit.
BERKELEY	Large, firm berries, medium flavor and some aroma. High dessert quality and good for freezing. Vigorous and productive with yellow canes. Five pounds average harvest.
BLUECROP	Standard of excellence. Large fruit with a good flavor. Good for fresh eating, and sparse foliage makes easy picking. Yields 12-20lbs./bush. Ripening over a month starting in mid July.
BLUEGOLD	Very cold hardy and berries have a long storage period. Fall foliage and winter wood are a nice golden yellow.
BLUEJAY	Early midseason. This extremely vigorous variety will grow almost twice as fast as most other blueberries. Bluejay features ample crops of medium-sized, mild-flavored berries that will stay on the bush for long periods of time without loss of fruit quality. A large bush, growing 6 – 7 feet tall.
BLUERAY	Large fruit with very sweet and slightly tart flavor, excellent quality. Vigorous, slender, multicaned bush with brilliant red fall color. Yields 12-20lbs. Self fruitful. Ripens early to mid-season.
BRIGITTA	Medium to large fruit with sweet, slightly tart, crisp flavor. Amazing shelf life. Vigorous, upright bush 4-6' tall. Ripens late season.
BRUNSWICK	A low bush variety forming a dense mat 6-8" tall and 4' wide. Pea sized fruit with sweet, wild flavor. Good fall color. Zones 3-7.
BURGUNDY	Vaccinium specialty. A standout selection from Maine with distinctive gray-green foliage, burgundy new growth, and light blue berries in summer. Growth is compact, about 3 ft. wide by 1 ft. tall. Deep burgundy fall color.
CHANDLER	Mid to late season. New variety! Giant fruits the size of cherries. Delicious flavor. Long ripening season over six weeks. Vigorous shrub to 5-6 feet tall. Zones 4-7.
CHIPPEWA	Mid-season. Medium to large berry. Excellent sweet flavor. Compact upright growth to 3-4'. Foliage turns brilliant red in autumn.
COVILLE	Mid-late season. Loose clusters of very large, firm fruit with good aromatic flavor. High quality fruit hangs on well, even when fully ripe. Excellent for freezing or jellies. Extremely vigorous, productive, upright bush to 4-6' tall.
DARROW	Very large fruits that are tart until ripe. Excellent flavor. Vigorous, upright bush growing 5-6' tall. Good variety for the P.N.W. Ripens early August.
DRAPER	Large, sweet berries. Thick skin gives it a nice, crisp texture. Highly productive. Grows 5-6'.
DUKE	Medium berries with mild flavor and good quality. Very productive, multi-caned bush growing 4-6' tall. Good for fresh eating and processing. Ripens early.
EARLIBLUE	One of the first to ripen. Nice medium size, sweet berries. Upright growth habit reaching 4-6'.
ELLIOT	Very late season. Medium, firm blue fruit with mild aromatic flavor. 4-6' upright growth with deep red and wine colored foliage in the fall.
HARDIBLUE	Exceptionally sweet, medium sized berry. Nicely adapted to heavier clay soils. Produces a heavy crop in summer.

HERBERT	Mid-season. Medium size, dark blue color berries. Outstanding, fine sweet flavor. Vigorous, slightly dwarf 4-6' tall and wide. Easy picking because fruits are borne on tips. Zones 4-7.
IVANHOE	Mid-season. Large to very large medium blue berries. Firm, crisp flesh with a delightful, sweet-tart flavor. High dessert quality and resists cracking. Vigorous, tall, upright bush. Heavy annual bearer.
JERSEY	Small to medium, juicy berries. Mild flavor. Vigorous, semi-upright plant to 5-7' with red wood. Yellow fall color. Good for shipping and processing. Ripens late August.
LEGACY	Medium-large light-blue fruit with robust flavor. Leaves are partially evergreen, with light fall hues. Plant is upright, reaching 6' at maturity. Late.
LIBERTY	Attractive fruit with outstanding firmness. Fast growing and upright. Reaches 4-5'.
MISTY	Medium fruit with mild, sweet flavor. Semi-evergreen variety makes a good low hedge. Reaches 4-6'.
NORTHBLUE	Plump, firm fruit with excellent wild blueberry flavor. Stores with refrigeration. Low bush variety growing 20-30" tall with red fall color. Yields 3-7lbs. Good for fresh eating or processing. Ripens mid-July.
NORTH-COUNTRY	Medium sized fruit with sweet wild flavor. Grows 18-24" tall and 30-40" wide. Sky blue flowers. Yields 2-7lbs. Ripens mid-July.
NORTH-LAND	Medium size, very sweet berries excellent for jams and baking. Grows 4' tall and wide with yellow wood. Yields 20lbs. Ripens mid-season. Zones 3-7.
NORTHSKY	Small to medium fruit with excellent wild flavor. Low spreading plant 10-18" tall by 24-36" wide. Yields 1-2lbs. Red fall color. Very hardy to -40°F. Ripens mid-July.
PATRIOT	Large berries with above average flavor. Upright bush to 4-6' tall with red wood. Yields 10-20lbs. Usually picked twice a season. Only variety resistant to <i>Phytophthora</i> . Tolerates wet, clay soils. Ripens early July.
POLARIS	Early season. Medium, firm sweet fruit. 3-4' compact upright growth. Recommended as an early ripening companion to Chippewa or Northblue.
REKA	Early season. New variety!! Excellent for the PNW. Exceptional flavor. Vigorous upright growth to 4-6ft.
RUBEL	Late-Mid season, Small fruit with intense flavor. This blueberry reaches 6 ft tall x 4-5 ft wide. It contains extremely high antioxidant levels. Very healthy berry.
SPARTAN	Large, firm fruit with excellent flavor. Superb fresh or in pies. Vigorous, upright bush with red wood. Very site specific preferring light, well drained soil with pH around 4.5. Ripens early.
SUNSHINE BLUE	Medium sized, tangy fruit. Evergreen, compact shrub growing 3' tall. Self fruitful. Yields 5-10lbs. Excellent for patio planters and specimen plants. Ripens in mid-July.
TOP HAT	Medium to large fruit with good flavor. Very small bush to 16-24" tall and 12-24" wide. Crimson fall color. Self fruitful. Perfect for containers.
TORO	Very large fruit with excellent firm quality. Tolerates fluctuating temperatures. Hot pink turning to white flowers. Excellent ornamental growing 4-6' tall. Ripens mid season.
