

SEA BERRY

Hippophae rhamnoides

Well-known in Europe, Sea Berries are highly prized for vitamin rich orange fruit and graceful ornamental qualities. Fruit is an excellent source of vitamins C, A & E and can make delicious juice. Plants have either male or female flowers, and female plants will produce fruit only when a male plant is present. Foliage is narrow and frosty blue-green and branches can be thorny. Sea Berries adapt to various soil conditions and have no pest or disease problems.

Grows to 8-12' tall - loves full sun - Hardy -40f



ORANGE DELIGHT	Abundant crops of flavorful, reddish-orange fruit. Fruit contains more than twice the Vitamin C of other varieties plus Vitamins E and A. Ripens mid to late September.
RUSSIAN ORANGE	Bears abundant crops of very large, flavorful, deep orange berries. Ripens in August.
MALE	Pollinator for female sea berries. Can pollinate up to 8 females.
