Thyme – Culinary & Ornamental Varieties

Culinary thyme aids the digestion and strengthens the immune system. Look for low growing/creeping thyme in the Ground Cover Section.

CAMPHOR THYME <i>T. camphoratus</i>	6-15” x16”	Strongly camphor scented, dark green, narrow foliage makes a shrublet of thyme. Covered with rose-pink flowers in late spring & summer. Compact.	7- 10
COMMON THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i>	12”	The standard cooking thyme. Gray green foliage. Tiny lilac flowers in June–July. Good container plant.	
DOT WELL’S FRENCH THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> ‘Dot Well’s”	8-10”	Excellent culinary variety. Small, narrow leaves. Oils, vinegars, meat, and potpourri.	5-6
ENGLISH THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> ‘Broadleaf English’	8”	Broad, small leaves. White flowers. Upright form. Good culinary herb, has a slightly sweeter fragrance than ‘French Thyme’.	
ENGLISH WEDGEWOOD THYME <i>T.</i> ‘English Wedgewood’	9”x14”	Chartreuse and green variegated leaves. Particularly nice round, upright habit, good flavor. Upright form.	6
FEN’S GRAY THYME <i>T.</i> ‘Fen’s Gray’	8”x18”	Tiny gray aromatic leaves on a small sub-shrub thyme. Decorative and culinary.	
FRENCH THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> ‘Narrow Leaf French’	1’x18”	White flowers, fine gray leaves. Upright form grows into shrubs or tiny trees. Excellent flavor, also a good ground cover.	7
GRAY HILL THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> ‘Gray Hill’	6-12x16”	New. Pale lavender flowers are sprinkled upon attractive narrow frosty gray leaves on this neat, upright little shrub. Culinary.	5
HI HO SILVER THYME	6-12”	Upright, attractive variation of Silver thyme w/more variegation. Mauve flowers.	
LEMON THYME <i>T. x citriodorus</i>	9-12x12- 16”	Bright green foliage, fresh lemon taste. Pink flowers. Culinary herb used in soups, chicken dishes and cookies. Upright form.	
LEMON THYME, GOLDEN <i>T. x citriodorus</i> ‘Aurea’ or ‘Aureus’	8”x12”	Gray-green leaves variegated w/yellow w/lemon scent and flavor. Upright habit, good ground cover. Lavender flowers July-August. Great in containers.	7
LEMON THYME, GOLDEN KING <i>T. x citriodorus</i> ‘Golden King’	8”x12”	Colorful and fragrant, brilliant gold-edged leaves. Lavender flowers in July-August. Upright form.	7

LEMON THYME, SILVER VARIEGATED <i>T. x citriodorus</i> 'Argentea'	8"x12"	Excellent lemon flavor. Glossy ivory and gray-green foliage. Slow growing. Upright form yet also a good ground cover.	7
MOONLIGHT THYME <i>T. leucotrichus</i>	6"x12"	Compact mound of silvery leaves. Profuse pink flowers in spring. Upright form.	4-9
ORANGE BALSAM <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Orange Balsam'	1'x18"	Neat and small upright shrub with narrow, orange scented leaves. Lavender flowers. Excellent in fruit salads and chicken dishes.	5
OREGANO THYME <i>T. pulegiodes</i> cv. 'Oregano'	10-12"	Bushy dark green leaves. Creeping form. Strong oregano-thyme flavor, good seasoning. Good indoor grower. Sun or part shade.	
PASSION PINK THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Passion Pink'		Beautiful upright thyme with/dwarf, compact habit. Narrow dark green foliage and bright pink flowers in summer. Strong aroma. Good culinary.	
PENNSYLVANIA DUTCH TEA <i>T. pugeloides</i> 'PA Dutch Tea'	10"	Semi shrub. Unique flavor, good for teas.	
PETER DAVIS THYME <i>T. mastichina</i> 'Peter Davis'	8-12"	Tiny, upright shrub with dense, needle-like bluish-green leaves. Beautiful pink flowers. Soft texture w/mild aroma. Lovely ornamental. Drought tolerant.	
PINEWOOD THYME <i>T.</i> 'Pinewood'	2"	Very slow grower, creeper. Narrow leaves. Pine-thyme scent. Large pink flowers. Drought tolerant. Perfect in rock gardens.	
PORLOCK THYME <i>T. praecox</i> or <i>serpyllum</i> 'Porlock'	8x12"	A British hybrid. Dark green leaves form a semi-upright mat covered w/bright pink flowers in summer. A good spreader. Also good for cooking.	5-9
PROVENCIAL THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Provencial'	8-12"	Tiny, narrow, gray-green leaves and white flowers. Strong citrus aroma. Very airy and attractive. Pretty, culinary variety.	5
SILVER THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Argenteus'	10 x12-18"	Low shrub with green and creamy white leaves, with a pink tinge in cold weather. Strong thyme aroma, very good flavor.	7
SILVER POSIE THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Silver Posie'		An improved silver thyme with slightly larger leaf and wider white margins on each leaf. Very nice. Mild common thyme flavor.	7
SILVER QUEEN <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Silver Queen'	6-8"	Silvery foliage and lemony fragrance.	7
TABOR THYME <i>T. vulgaris</i> 'Tabor'	12"	Pungent, creeping thyme w/pink flowers in midsummer. Leaves are dark green and very round.	
TUFFET THYME <i>T. caespitius</i> 'Tuffet'		Dense mounds of bright green, narrow, little leaves. Rose-pink flowers bloom from late spring to summer. Tangerine-pine scent.	
WINTER THYME <i>T. hyemalis</i>	6"x16"	Tough, compact, evergreen culinary thyme.
