

## Slicing Tomatoes

**Determinate types typically spread laterally and do not need staking. Tomatoes on determinate plants also tend to ripen together, which is a great quality if you are processing. Indeterminate types continue to grow and produce until frost and need staking or trellising for best production.**

<b>ABE LINCOLN</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Dark red meaty fruits with sweet taste. Juicy fruits up to 3 lbs. each. No cracks, few seeds.	77-87
<b>ACE</b>	Determinate Large/Slicing	This tomato produces high yields of large, 8-10 oz., smooth, deep oblate fruit. This variety is lower in acid than other tomato varieties.	75
<b>BEAUTY</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	12-16oz, delicious flavor, keeps well after harvest, great slicer, exceptional yields	75
<b>BEEFMASTER</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	One if America's favorite for the solid, meaty, flavorful red fruit that weighs up to 2 lbs. Vigorous vines and outstanding fruit taste and quality.	80
<b>BEEFSTEAK</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	Produces huge 1½ lb., delicious, ribbed fruit on vigorous vines. Grow in wire cages for best results.	96
<b>BETTER BOY</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Firm and perfect slicing tomato. Rugged vine produces large crops, 12 to 16 oz. Smooth, flavorful fruit. Disease resistant.	75
<b>BETTER BUSH</b>	Indeterminate Slicing/Dwarf	Large, globe-shaped fruit, 3-4" in diameter. Firm, meaty and juicy. Compact plant ideal for small gardens and containers.	72
<b>BIG BITE</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	A long shot beefsteak, crops early and often, yielding season long harvests of 14 oz. fruits that are meaty and uniform. Acidic, true tomato flavor.	75
<b>BIG BEEF</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	1994 All-American Selections Award! Extra large, 10-12 oz. Smooth tomatoes with real old-time flavor. Great disease resistance.	73
<b>BIG BOY</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Classic red slicing tomato. 3" flattened globe shaped fruit. Tangy flavor.	82

<b>BIG ZAC</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	An excellent tomato in every respect - meaty and delicious, , very disease resistant, and true-growing each time it's planted.	80
<b>BLOODY BUTCHER</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	A sensational, multi-purpose tomato, very early and high-yielding. Strong tomato flavor in medium, round, 4 oz. fruits that are a deep, dark red inside and out. Potato-leaved plants are fast growing.	55
<b>BONNY BEST</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	An-old-fashioned favorite, popular for its harvest of smooth, meaty fruit with pleasantly acidic flavor; as large as 8 oz. Best to grow in wire cage.	76
<b>BOX CAR WILLIE</b>	Indeterminate Late/Slicing	Heavy crop of 6-10 oz. fruit. Excellent tasting variety for the later end of the season.	80
<b>BURPEE'S BIG BOY</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	Large, firm, meaty fruit average weight is 1 lb. A perfect substitute to Beefsteak.	78
<b>BUSH EARLY GIRL</b>	Determinate Compact/Slicing	"Little Sister" to Early Girl. Huge yields on small plants. 6-7 oz. fruit is larger than Early Girl and has good flavor. More disease resistance than original.	54
<b>CARMELO</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Large, juicy fruit with exceptional flavor. Prolific producer. Great for fresh eating and in salads.	70
<b>CARO RICH</b>	Determinate Slicing	Orange colored beefsteak. High Vitamin A and Beta Carotene content. Low acid. Sweet globe shaped fruit.	72
<b>CASPIAN PINK</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Large, somewhat flat, sweet, juicy, soft fruits.	80
<b>CELEBRITY</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	Exceptionally flavorful, firm 7-8 oz. fruit on strong vines with good cover and outstanding disease resistance. Highly productive and adaptable.	70
<b>CLUSTER GRANDE</b>	Indeterminate Cluster	Bears 5 oz. tomatoes in clusters that have excellent shelf life and flavor.	63
<b>EARLY CASCADE</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Ripens early and continues heavy yields, produces bumper crops. Clusters of 2", firm, bright red fruit. Delicious for salads, canning & sauces. Disease resistant.	55
<b>EARLY GIRL</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	One of the very earliest slicing tomatoes. More disease resistance than the original Early Girl, but bears the same large harvests of flavorful, solid 4-6 oz. fruit.	52
<b>EARLY GOLIATH</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	10-12oz globe-shaped, exceptionally sweet flavor, with large harvests, disease resistant.	58

<b>ESTIVA</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	6-8oz firm, smooth superb flavor, crack and disease resistant,	70
<b>FANTASTIC</b>	Indeterminate	Big crops of smooth, 8 oz. fruit of fine texture and delicious flavor. Heavy bearer throughout the growing season.	85
<b>FIRST LADY</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Extremely early, produces an abundance of 4-5 oz. flavorful red fruit. Very disease resistant. Continue to set over long period. Better flavor than Early Girl	66
<b>FIRST PRIZE</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	The kind if tomato home gardeners would love to grow for a county fair entry. Vigorous plants yield delicious, 10-12 oz. fruits. Good disease resistance.	75
<b>GLACIER</b>	Determinate Compact/Slicing	Ultra early, sweet “salad” type. Deep red, 2 ½-3” fruits. Compact plants. Perfect for postage stamp gardens and raised beds. Developed in Sweden.	55
<b>GRANNY SMITH</b>	Indeterminate Slicing/Grilling	Fruits are still green when fully ripe (harvest when it shows a little light-yellow color), with a full, sweet, natural bit more tartness than red types. Its full size, 6 to 8 oz., and firmness makes it unsurpassed for grilling or frying. Two-week keeping time!	72
<b>GOLIATH</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	Smooth bright-red, deep oblate fruits averaging 10 to 15 oz., sweet luscious flavor, virtually blemish-free exterior. Tall vigorous plants with high yield, and modern disease resistance makes Goliath widely adaptable.	65
<b>HARZFEUER</b>	Determinate Slicing	Dependable, disease resistant, beautiful and flavorful it produces huge clusters of fruit. Fruit weight 3-4 oz.	69
<b>HEALTH KICK</b>	Determinate Slicing	Medium sized plum shaped red fruits. 50% more lycopene (an antioxidant). Great flavor, abundant producer.	70
<b>HELLFRUCHT</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	6-8oz heavy producer, great taste, grows well in greenhouse or field	72
<b>ITALIAN MARKET WONDER</b>	Large/Slicing	Very resistant to disease, large round fruits are beautiful and deep red.	75
<b>JETSETTER</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	Fruit is at least 8 ozs. Often larger with exceptional good flavor.	64
<b>JET STAR</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Superior, very pleasant taste. Heavy yields of 8 oz. firm, meaty fruit that is generally free of cracks. Low in acid. Not recommended for canning.	72
<b>LEGEND</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	Medium, tasty, round fruit. Resistant to LATE BLIGHT FUNGUS.	68

<b>LONG KEEPER</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	If picked ripe in late fall and store properly, tomatoes can last through the winter w/out change in flavor or texture. Ripe peel is light golden orange red.	78
<b>MEXICO</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	1 lb. pink fruit. Outstanding flavor	75
<b>MOMOTARO</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	6-7oz most popular in Japan, very sweet, tough skin, durable, disease tolerant, good storability	70
<b>MORETON HYBRID</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Old-time favorite. Vine is vigorous, and bears a heavy foliage cover. Fruits are medium-sized, firm and meaty. 6-8 oz.	70
<b>MOSKOVICH</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	A rich tasting, medium sized, globe shaped tomato with 4-6 oz. fruits. Produces very early. Hardy, cold tolerant. Originated in Siberia.	60
<b>NEW GIRL</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	6-8oz, smooth, firm, excellent flavor, some say better than Early Girl	62
<b>NEW YORKER</b>	Indeterminate Slicing	Beefsteak, compact, meaty set fruit well in cool short-season weather.	66
<b>ODORIKO</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	Japanese variety with pink, medium to large, round fruits. Vigorous plants, disease resistant and productive. Beautiful tomatoes are rich, sweet and tangy.	76
<b>OREGON SPRING</b>	Determinate Slicing	A cold-tolerant tomato developed by OSU for short season gardeners. Compact plants produce concentrated sets of 4" fruit that is nearly seedless.	58
<b>OREGON STAR</b>	Indeterminate Large/Slicing	Large, juicy delicious fruit. Sets fruit early. Makes thick creamy juice, slicer, fresh.	80
<b>PARK'S WHOPPER</b>	Indeterminate All purpose	Prolific red beefsteak. Delicious fresh, cooked or canned.	65
<b>PERON</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	Medium-large, 8 oz., bright red, quite firm, good flavored fruits. Higher in vitamin C than other tomatoes. Naturally disease resistant. Strong vines.	68
<b>PIK-RED</b>	Determinate Slicing	6-7 oz. smooth, meaty fruit, noted for almost solid interiors allowing farmers to pick them red-ripe for local markets. Sturdy, dwarf, vines. Grow close together.	71
<b>SANTIAM</b>	Determinate Slicing	Medium-sized, very early, seedless fruit. Very good, rich, delicious flavor. Matures before Oregon Spring. Developed at OSU.	52-75
<b>SILETZ</b>	Determinate	The early standard for the Pacific NW. Large, 4-5", deep red, seedless 1 lb. fruit.	70-75

<b>SOLAR SET</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	Good selection for hot house or indoor hydro. A heat tolerant variety developed at the University of Florida. Large yields of 8-9 oz. fruits with a good flavor.	70
<b>SUPERSONIC</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	8-10oz, firm, meaty, smooth, excellent flavor, crack and disease resistant	75
<b>SWEET CLUSTER</b>	Indeterminate Cluster	Produces ling clusters of 6-8, red 4 oz. tomatoes that ripen at the same time. Sweet and delicious.	67
<b>TONDINA MAREMMANO</b>	Determinate Cluster	Clusters of 4 to 6 oz. Fruits. Excellent for slicing.	69
<b>TUSCANY</b>	Determinate Medium/Salad	Abundant, round red, 3-4 oz. fruits with superb flavor and texture. This is a very useful hybrid for salsa, drying, canning, saucing or salads. Great for Italian cooking	75
<b>ULTIMATE OPENER</b>	Indeterminate Medium/Slicing	6-8oz, sweet and juicy, blemish free, very productive	57
<b>WILLAMETTE</b>	Determinate Medium/Slicing	Medium sized fruit are meaty, mild flavored and crack resistant. A favorite here in the Willamette Valley for its good production in spite of unfavorable weather.	75
