

Winter Berries

Billardiera longifolia Climbing Blueberry - Evergreen climber with lance shaped leaves & cool large hanging dark purple berries. Protect from extreme wind & cold. Sun or shade.

Callicarpa spp. Beautyberry – Charming shrubs with branches studded with clusters of fairytale purple berries. Rare color outdoors or in arrangements. Sun-pt shade.

Cotoneaster spp. – Deciduous or evergreen, some tall, some small, all offer masses of bright red or orange berries that are hard to beat. Sun.

Ilex verticillata Winterberry – Long lasting plump berries of reds or oranges on deciduous shrubs or small trees with fine structural character & handsome bark. Needs a male pollinator. Sun.

Pernettya mucronata – Tidy shrub with evergreen pointed leaves. Produces cute round berries of white, red, purple or pink on upright stems. Compact, 2-3'. Sun-pt shade.

Sorbus spp. Mountain Ash – Trees with white, pink or florescent orange berries that persist well into the winter & are enjoyed by birds. Sun-light shade.

Symphoricarpos spp. Snowberry, Coralberry – Upright deciduous shrubs with clusters of round berries of white, lavender or ruby pink. Useful in arrangements & attractive to birds. Sun-pt shade.
